Reduced rates at kindergartens and before and after school clubs (SFO)

Low-income families can apply for kindergarten and before and after school club (SFO) places at a reduced rate. Core hours at kindergarten are also free if you are on a low income. Free core hours means that your child can attend kindergarten 20 hours per week at no cost to you.

You qualify for a reduced rate if your kindergarten/SFO fees amount to more than six per cent of your household's total income.

In order to apply for a reduced rate at a kindergarten and before and after school club, the applicant must be registered at the same address in the Norwegian Population Register as the child.

Before you can apply for a reduced rate, you must have accepted a place at kindergarten/SFO.

The reduced fees applies to attendance at kindergarten/SFO. You must still pay for food.

Families with multiple children at kindergarten/SFO can also receive a sibling discount, which means the fees are reduced. You do not need to apply for this.

How to apply

- 1. Sign in here: <u>Vigilo parent portal</u> (in Norwegian only).
- 2. Once you have signed in, you will see the name of your children who have a place at kindergarten or SFO. Select 'Søknader' in the menu on the left. Click 'Ny søknad' and select 'Redusert betaling'. Insert a cross for all the children you are applying for.
- 3. Insert all the taxpayers and capital income of the family registered at the same address as the child in the 'Samlet bruttoinntekt' field.
- 4. When processing your application, we automatically obtain documentation of the family's gross income from the Norwegian Tax Administration. Your tax return for the previous year is used as a basis for calculation.
- 5. You will receive a reply approx. three weeks after submitting your application. If you are entitled to reduced fees, you will pay the reduced rate already the month after you applied.
