Ytre Arna has a welcoming class for newly arrived minority-language pupils in years 3-7. The pupils are from Arna and Åsane and receive their first Norwegian lessons here.

The school uses Nynorsk as it's main written language, though many pupils use Bokmål.

The school has its own swimming pool.
